They have learned to:

- Tell the bully to stop
- If they don't, tell a trusted adult at school and/or at home
- Write it down, put it in the worry box

KS2 watched a performance called be a Super Hero School, which gave us all a very clear message about what bullying is and how we can help ourselves and help each other. Year 5 pupils took part in drama workshops to follow up on the theme of Choose Respect.

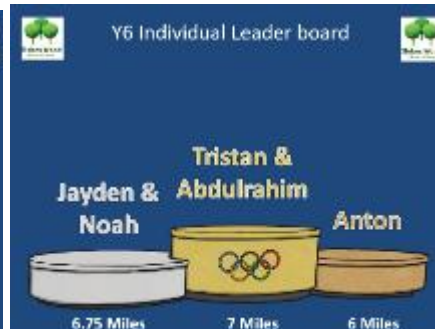
