If you have concerns regarding the support your child with SEND is receiving, please contact Mrs Woods and or Mrs Gadsby.

All parents have the opportunity to attend 2 parents' evenings a year, one in October and one in March. If you are not able to attend either of these, you can make an appointment through the office at another time or you can receive a phone call from your child's teacher. You will also receive a written report at the end of the summer term.

Our commitment is to do our very best for every child and we want to work with parents to ensure all children achieve their potential by the end of Y6.

Summary of responses:

- 1. My child is happy at this school. 83% agree (4% don't know)
- 2. My child feels safe at this school. 95% agree

- 3. The school makes sure its pupils are well behaved. 92% agree
- 4. My child has been bullied and the school dealt with the bullying quickly and effectively. 74% say their child has not been bullied 9% agree.
- 5. The school makes me aware of what my child will learn during the year. 82% agree with 4% don't know
- 6. When I have raised concerns with the school they have been dealt with properly. 39% have had no concern, 44% agree
- 7. My child has SEND, and the school gives them the support they need to succeed. **3 responses 33% agree**
- 8. The school has high expectations for my child. 82% agree 4% don't know
- 9. My child does well at this school. 83% agree 4% don't know
- 10. The school lets me know how my child is doing. 78% agree 4% don't know
- 11. There is a good range of subjects available to my child at this school. **92% agree**4% don't know
- 12. My child can take part in clubs and activities at this school. 100% agree
- 13.. The school supports my child's wider personal development. 83% agree
- 14. I would recommend this school to another parent. 83% agree

Additional parent comment:

These are things that I think Stokes Wood do very well:

- Care for my son in the best possible way, enabling him to be included in everything- even if this can be a challenge to him. (SEN)
- Build upon my son's interests- My son is such an outdoor child, and this is met exceptionally well.
- Follow my child's lead at drop off time- changing their own routines in the morning to enable a smooth drop off for my son.

I'd also like to add that son is still in nappies due to delay in development & having SEN needs, this was my biggest worry for him but this has been made so manageable and his teachers are super caring and attentive to his each and every need! I'm so happy!

Also, we are addressed so positively in the mornings and afternoons by the teachers/staff at the bottom gate- even in pouring down rain- so jolly and know my sons name already!! Only been coming a month!!!!

Things I feel could just be improved are a few more photos and posts on my son's evidence me- I'm a nosey Mum and love to see his adventures and every little target because we have been long awaiting these alongside his SEN difficulties.
